- 7) How do you make prayer and fasting an ongoing part of your life? If it's not an ongoing part of your life, what changes do you need to make in order to move in that direction?
- 8) Richard mentioned that in Acts 14:28 Paul never mentions his suffering but only tells of the work God did through them. What type of speech characterizes you--speaking about the work of God or complaints about your suffering? Depending on your answer, what does this say about your relationship with Christ?
