The Holy Spirit Came

Acts 2:1-4,22-42

MAIN POINT: THE HOLY SPIRIT CAME TO THE APOSTLES ON THE DAY OF PENTECOST.

On the day of Pentecost, Jesus' disciples were gathered together in Jerusalem All of a sudden, a sound came from heaven. Then tongues appeared like flames of fire, and they rested on each of the disciples. The disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit, and the Holy Spirit gave them the ability to speak in different languages!

Peter spoke to a crowd that had gathered. "God pointed out to you Jesus the Nazarene," he said. "Even though God planned for Jesus to die, you used lawless people to nail Him to a cross and kill Him. But death did not keep hold of Jesus; God raised Jesus from the dead."

The Holy Spirit convinced the people that Peter was telling the truth. "What must we do to be saved?" they asked.

Peter told the people to repent. Everyone who believed Peter's message was baptized. That day, about 3,000 people joined Jesus' followers.

Christ Connection: God kept His promise to send the Holy Spirit. With the Holy Spirit's help, Jesus' disciples could begin their work to share the gospel with the entire world. God gives the Holy Spirit to those who trust in Jesus as Lord and Savior. The Holy Spirit gives us power to do God's work, and He changes us to be more like Jesus.
