Scripture text(s): Ephesians 3:14-21

- 1) Read Ephesians 3: 14-21. What is the condition of your prayer life?
- 2) Does Christ dwell in every part of your heart? What areas of your heart are you withholding? What steps can you take to give Him full access?
- 3) How suitable is your inner being for Christ to reside?
- 4) Richard gave us Lenski's quote, "Christ takes possession of us in an ever-increasing degree." Does this characterize your life? In what ways can Christ become more and you become less?
- 5) As Richard described God's love in terms of width, length, height, and depth, how were you encouraged? Are you convinced of this kind of love for you by the Father? If not, why?
- 6) Read Ephesians 3:19. Discuss the phrase, "and to know this love that surpasses knowledge..." What did Richard say this meant? How is this played out in our lives?
- 7) Ponder Richard's statement "God has no degree of difficulty." How does this spur you on and bring you encouragement? How does this point you to His limitless abilities and resources?
