- 3) What does your prayer life look like? What steps can you take this week that would lead to a richer, more intimate prayer life?
- 4) Read verse 8. What is of primary importance?
- 5) Dan said that as persecution increases, the risk of letting up on love increases. Why is this true? How can we combat this?
- 6) Read Proverbs 10:12. Discuss this principle and share an experience you've had where this was illustrated.
- 7) Read verse 9. How do you practice hospitality? How have you seen hospitality minister God's love to someone?
- 8) Read verses 10-11. What gift/gifts has God given you? How do you use them?
- 9) What did Dan say was the purpose of these 4 things?
