Scripture text(s): Psalm 42

- 1) Read Psalm 42:1-2. Who was David longing for? What evidence shows this? What/Who are you longing for? What evidence is there to show what you're longing for?
- 2) How do you know when you're thirsty?
- 3) What did Dan say was the significance of the deer looking for "streams" of water? How does this encourage you in your relationship with the Lord?
- 4) Read Psalm 42:3-4, 7, and 10. Who was David craving? What do you crave most? Why does it matter that we crave the Lord or not?
- 5) In verse 4, David remembers going to the house of God and the joy of communion with Him and people. What things do you remember that bring you hope and joy?
- 6) Discuss God's sovereignty in these scriptures. How did David acknowledge His sovereignty? In what ways do you acknowledge it in your own life? Why is it important to see God as sovereign?
- 7) Read Psalm 42:5 & 11. Where was David's hope found?
- 8) Where is your hope found? In these trying times of uncertainty, how can you share the hope of Christ with others?
