- 6) Richard mentioned Jean-Paul Sarte's philosophy that has influenced many. "Every existing thing is born without wisdom, prolongs itself out of weakness, and dies by chance." How is this philosophy still affecting us today?
- 7) How have you seen God moving in your life these last 5 weeks? How has God used you to bring hope and help?
