Sermon Title: Exalting God Through Pandemic

Scripture text(s): Psalm 46:1-11

- 1) Read Psalm 46:1-11. Why is God the safest place to be?
- 2) Richard gave us three crisis points: (1) God is present in the crisis. Walk with Him. (2) God is powerful over the crisis. Wait for Him. (3) God has purpose in the crisis. Worship Him. How do these points magnify Him? How do these points give you hope?
- 3) Read Psalm 46:10. Why is this verse important to our daily lives in this time of crisis?
- 4) In what ways is God urging you to slow down? What areas of your life are frenzied?
- 5) Richard said, "We have awarded our highest affections to unworthy substitutes." What receives your highest affection? What do you need to let go of?
- 6) Richard mentioned three idols that are being destroyed by this crisis: (1) our security (2) prosperity (3) wellness. Think about how these idols may have a root in your life. What is God saying to you concerning this?
- 7) How can God be exalted through your response to Him during this crisis?
- 8) How can your prayer life exalt God?
- 9) How can you exalt God in the midst of this crisis through your giving?
- 10) How does God want you to be a witness through this crisis?
- 11) How can your attitude bring exaltation to God?
