**Sermon Title: Gospel-Driven Justice**

**Scripture text(s):**

- 1) Dan gave us 5 questions about justice, the first of which is "Why preach on justice?" Discuss some reasons of why preaching on justice is important.
- 2) Dan named some errors that we need to avoid: don't lose Jesus in seeking justice and don't let it become a distraction from the gospel. How can either or both creep into our lives? What are results of either of these errors? What are some ways we can avoid them?
- 3) The second question Dan gave is "What does justice mean?" Discuss the meaning. Read Micah 6:8. What does the Lord require? How can these become a part of our lives on a daily basis?
- 4) The third question Dan gave is "What does justice say about your religion?" Read Isaiah 1:4, 9, 11, and 17. How were the Israelites living? How can this be true of us today? What does God want for us?
- 5) The fourth question Dan gave is "What did Jesus say about justice?" What was Christ's attitude toward the poor? How can we live out this attitude?
- 6) The fifth question Dan gave is "Why should we do justice?" And what is our motivation for doing it?
- 7) What does the image of God have to do with doing justice?
- 8) How does our experience with God's grace influence how and why we do justice?
