Scripture text(s): Luke 16:19-31

- 1) Read Luke 16:19-31. What did Richard say was the point of this parable?
- 2) How do our decisions in this life affect our eternal destiny?
- 3) Read Luke 16:25. What is the significance of Abraham saying to the rich man, "Remember..."?
- 4) Read Hebrews 8:12 and Micah 7:19. What is the significance of these two verses?
- 5) With the previous two questions/scriptures in mind, compare and contrast the eternal destiny of the rich man and Lazarus.
- 6) What life lessons does Jesus want us to learn from the rich man and Lazarus?
- 7) Read Luke 16:27-31. Why did Abraham say that the rich man's brothers and family have Moses and the Prophets? What does that mean? How is someone coming to them dead not enough?
- 8) Richard repeated this statement several times, "We know what we are doing." What does that statement mean in the context of this scripture?
- 9) Richard said, "The fault is never with the insufficiency of God's warnings but with man's determination to resist the will of God." In what ways do we resist the will of God? In what ways do we try to ignore God's warnings? What is the outcome of our choice to ignore God and resist Him individually and as a nation?
