

## Our Great High Priest Hebrews 4:14-16

**Take-Home Truth:** *Jesus is the Great High Priest.*

**Christ-Connection:** *We need Jesus' perfect priesthood, person, and provision.*

**Hook:** *(Ice-breaker question. Get the group talking!)*

1. Tell about a time you settled for less out of impatience, expediency, convenience, etc. What was your result?

**Engage:** *(Observe the passage and engage with the text)*

2. Read Hebrews 4:14-16. As you read these verses, identify words or phrases that show Jesus' perfect:

- A) Priesthood (v14)
- B) Person (v15)
- C) Provision (v16)

**Reflect:** *(Reflect upon the key take-aways from the sermon)*

3. The Old Testament high priest was tasked with interceding for the people. What does this tell you about Jesus' work for you now?

4. Verse 15 says Jesus was tempted in every way, yet without sin. What does it mean to you, knowing He can sympathize with you in your failings?

**Respond:** *(Apply the truths of God's Word to your heart, affections, and actions)*

5. Verse 16 tells us to draw near to God with confidence. How do the truths of this passage draw you toward Him?

6. A.W. Tozer said "what comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us." How does this passage help you understand how God sees you differently?
