"Of Course He Will"

Take-Home Truth: We are confident Jesus will return because He came the first time.

Christ-Connection: Jesus is the source of our hope while waiting.

Hook: (Ice-breaker question. Get the group talking!)

1. Talk about something you've done or experienced once that you can't wait to do again.

Engage: (Observe the passage and engage with the text)

2. As a group read and discuss the implications of waiting/suffering in this world and finding comfort through Christ's Second Coming through the following verses:
