

# Great Commission Sunday

## Matthew 28:19-20/Acts 1:8

**Take-Home Truth:** *“It is the whole job of the whole church to preach the whole gospel to the whole world.” Spurgeon*

**Christ-Connection:** *Jesus’ final command was “go and make disciples”.*

**Hook:** *(Ice-breaker question. Get the group talking!)*

1. Tell about an obscure skill you have and a time it has been useful to you.

**Engage:** *(Observe the passage and engage with the text)*

2. Read the Great Commission in Matthew 28:19-20 and Acts 1:8.

3. Chris Burton, in his video message, called the church “ground zero” for reaching the world with the Gospel. How is the local church essential to the Great Commission?

**Reflect:** *(Reflect upon the key take-aways from the sermon)*

4. What are some of the misconceptions about missions Amy addressed? How did she help you understand the various ways God equips his people? How are you drawn to serve as a result?

5. When asked how they moved from the pew to their current role, David and Sawyer both referenced God’s grace toward them. How does the gospel compel you to live on mission?

**Respond:** *(Apply the truths of God’s Word to your heart, affections, and actions)*

6. We heard a variety of mission needs from the panelists. Which of these seemed like a natural next step for you? What is your hesitation to go?

7. What sacrifices would you be willing to make to live more fully on mission?
