

Come Out of Her My People

Revelation 17:14-18, 18:1-4

Take-Home Truth: *Come out of the world so that you will not share in her sins.*

Christ-Connection: *Christ invites us to come to Him for deliverance from the culture and for salvation.*

Recap:

1. As you have seen evil increase in our culture, how have you been able to find hope?

Engage: *(Observe the passage and engage with the text)*

2. Read Revelation 17:14-18 and 18:1-4. (See Judges 6:33 and 7:22) How does evil destroy itself? What are some examples of evil destroying itself in culture and/or our own lives?
3. Reread Revelation 17:17. What evidence is there to support the fact that God is in control and restraining the degree of evil in our world today?

Reflect: *(Reflect upon the key take-aways from the sermon)*

4. In what ways does the prostitute allure us to follow her?
5. Richard said that living for ourselves destroys others. How have you seen this played out in your life and in the culture? (1 Corinthians 10:24 and Philippians 2:3-4)

Respond: *(Apply the truths of God's Word to your heart, affections, and actions)*

6. What will coming out of the world mean for you? Do you see a need for an action plan? Discuss some steps you can take this week in order to formulate a plan.
7. Reflect on the testimony of Pastor Epratha and his ministry in India. How were you challenged/encouraged by our brothers and sisters there?
