Come Out of Her My People

Revelation 17:14-18, 18:1-4

Take-Home Truth: Come out of the world so that you will not share in her sins.

Christ-Connection: Christ invites us to come to Him for deliverance from the culture and for salvation.

Recap:

1. As you have seen evil increase in our culture, how have you been able to find hope?

Engage: (Observe the passage and engage with the text)

- Read Revelation 17:14-18 and 18:1-4. (See Judges 6:33 and 7:22) How does evil destroy itself? What are some examples of evil destroying itself in culture and/or our own lives?
- 3. Reread Revelation 17:17. What evidence is there to support the fact that God is in control and restraining the degree of evil in our world today?

Reflect: (Reflect upon the key take-aways from the sermon)

- 4. In what ways does the prostitute allure us to follow her?
- Richard said that living for ourselves destroys others. How have you seen this played out in your life and in the culture? (1 Corinthians 10:24 and Philippians 2:3-4)

Respond: (Apply the truths of God's Word to your heart, affections, and actions)

- 6. What will coming out of the world mean for you? Do you see a need for an action plan? Discuss some steps you can take this week in order to formulate a plan.
- 7. Reflect on the testimony of Pastor Epratha and his ministry in India. How were you challenged/encouraged by our brothers and sisters there?
