Take-Home Truth: Feelings are important to God but must be associated with obedience.

Christ-Connection: Those who love Jesus obey Jesus (John 14:15).

Distinguishing Marks of the Work of the Spirit of God:

1. Increased desire to honor Jesus Christ as the Son of God who saves us from our sins.
2. Increased efforts to oppose the kingdom of Satan because he entices the world to sin.
3. Increased love for the Bible as people see it as the God-inspired book that reveals life-changing truth.
4. Increased hunger to live one's life according to the truth of God.
5. Increased love for God and an increased love for man.
