"Compassion that Creates Mission"

Matthew 9:35-38

Take-Home Truth: We need to see people differently, as Jesus does, in order to have compassion for them.

Christ-Connection: Christ is the example of the compassion for others we should model and the mission we should have in our lives.

Respond: (Apply the truths of God's Word to your heart, affections, and actions)

- 7. What changes can you make this week to have more compassion toward others?
- 8. Who in your circle is "harassed" that God is leading you to reach out to this week?
