Recap:

- 3. Create one clear and concise statement to be the Take Home Truth of Sunday's Word.
- 4. Read John 14:8-11. How does Jesus show Phillip and the disciples that he is the fullness of God?

Reflect:

- 5. In Colossians 1:18, He is referred to as preeminent (supreme, superior, and unrivaled) what does this mean for our lives? What are we qualified through Christ to inherit?
- 6. Have you experienced seasons of life where you grew in knowledge about the faith but not in love for Christ? How do you make sure that your knowledge is creating an increase love for Jesus?

Respond:

- 7. In what ways do you long to see the supremacy of Jesus more revealed in your life? What is one practical area of your life you can commit to change this week, in light of the WORD?
- 8. How Does the WORD lead you to live on mission? Be practical and specific.
